Fire/EMS - Chief Moulden

- Chief Moulden recommends continuing with the 5-year plan of ambulance replacement. Three quotes were presented to the board to re-chassis the 2008 ambulance.
 - o ARROW Manufacturing \$187,464.00
 - o Lifeline Ambulance \$156,465.00
 - o Emergency Mobile Technologies \$87,041.00
- Chief recommends going with Emergency Mobile Technologies. This is the same company that is doing the re-chassis on the 2015 ambulance.
- The Board agreed for the Chief to ask for the contract and send it to the County Prosecutor and to get the contract from Kansas State Bank.
- Corona Virus Relief Funds Update: Lucas devices and UVC Lights ordered.
- Ambulance Repairs: Insurance Company will issue checks for the Ambulance repair, cardiac monitor, cot, and small equipment. We will hold the large check until the Ambulance repairs are complete.
- The Board discussed COVID-19 pandemic standard procedures and protocols with Chief Moulden for EMS Staff regarding daily operations.

Roads - Jason Browning

- Hot Box in use now. 3 ton laid on Johnson Road. Estimate 3 to 6 ton to complete patching for the year.
- Road mowing 2nd round started.

Cemetery – Trustee Hinners

- YTD Revenue = \$20,203.50
- Plainview Cemetery Pipes are installed in the new section. Grass seed will be sewn when settled and graded properly. No equipment was rented for this project. Plan to work on the old section when complete.
- The Township had 2 indigent cremations. The Board discussed filing for "Indigent Burial and Cremation Support Program Reimbursement".

- The Board discussed concerns of junk yard on Hunt Road (Bakers), and cars on Long Glady increasing again.
- Issue with Liberty Street, behind West Main. Village had granted 60 foot right of way on one side (South). The Auditor has it listed as such. Landowner wants it reduced. Jason Browning will check with the Auditor to confirm. Still a Zoning issue.
