

Storm Debris Management

Assistance with debris from 7/6/22 Tornado.

Trash & Construction Debris

If you have storm debris that cannot be removed through your insurance, you can take to Stonelick State Park, 2895 Lake Dr., Pleasant Plain, OH 45162. The dumpsters are located on the overflow parking lot to the left before the beach parking lot (follow signs to the beach), **7/14-7/17, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm**. Residents would need to unload the material as limited staff is available. *Please do not place construction debris (lumber, siding, roofing material) at the curb as it cannot be picked-up curbside.*

Woody and Vegetative Debris

Residents can place woody/vegetative debris at the right of way for pick-up by public works. It must be kept separate from any trash at the curb; cutting logs to 4' lengths is helpful. It may take several weeks to get to your street. **If you need help with tree services, cutting and hauling woody debris to the curb, please visit the website below or email or call the hotline below.** Volunteer organizations are working in the area.

Residents can haul woody debris to Bzak Landscaping at 931 Round Bottom Rd, Milford, OH 45150 free of charge. The woody debris management site at Stonelick State Park is **NOT** open to the public or contractors due to liability issues.
