

S.R. 133 RESURFACING PROJECT SET TO BEGIN IN APRIL

Resurfacing is set to begin on state Route 133 in Clermont County, with construction getting under way in mid-April.

Contractors for the Ohio Department of Transportation will be resurfacing S.R. 133, between S.R. 32 at Williamsburg and S.R. 131, east of Newtonsville. In addition to a four-inch resurfacing through the length of the project, construction will include paving the ramps at the S.R. 32 interchange and replacing the pavement edge in the section between U.S. 50 and S.R. 131.

Construction to replace the pavement edge in the section between U.S. 50 and S.R. 131 will start Monday, April 15, and while traffic on northbound S.R. 133 will be maintained with the use of flaggers, southbound S.R. 133 motorists will be detoured by way of S.R. 131 and U.S. 50.

The directional closure will be lifted once the edge work has been completed, and this is anticipated to be in early June. During paving operations and through the remainder of the project, two-way traffic will be maintained by flaggers within the length of the entire work zone.

Barrett Paving Materials was awarded a contract in the amount of approximately \$6 million to complete the project, and all work associated with the project is scheduled to be completed in late fall of this year.
